

REQUESTING A BALLOT BY MAIL

Who qualifies for an Application for a Ballot by Mail?

- 65 years of age or older
- Out of the county during the entire election including early voting
- Disabled
- Confined in jail, but eligible to vote. *(This application is only good for one election and runoff.)*
- In need of an Emergency Ballot Due to Death in Family
- Military or Overseas voters and their families who will be out of the area during Early Voting- Requires an FPCA Application

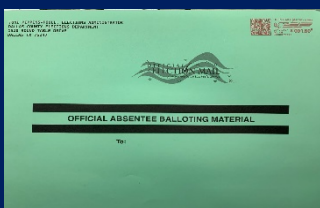

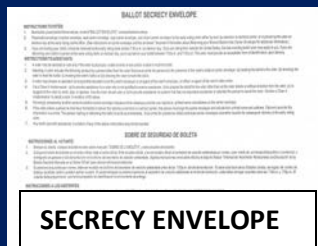
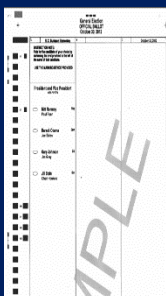

YOUR BALLOT WILL ARRIVE IN A LIGHT GREEN ENVELOPE



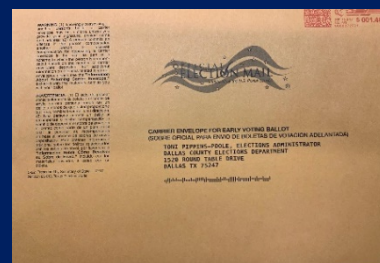
VOTE YOUR BALLOT AND INSERT INSIDE SECRECY ENVELOPE
